



Youth Connexions XC Outcomes

In the Business Plan for XC Centre were project outcomes for Dacorum Sports Trust and others for Youth Connexions.

Youth Connexions outcomes are:

- 1)** 300 young people to move into EET or positive accredited outcomes (of whom 10% are special needs and 10% BME) this will specifically include 25 young persons per year to engage on the “ExtremeConnexions” volunteer programme and 5 of these to become paid employees.

- 2)** 2000 young people per year (of whom 10% are special needs and 10% BME) to receive sexual health/substance misuse and abuse advice/awareness (including provision of free condoms)

- 3)** To provide a focal point for the community and third sector agencies to co-operate more effectively in delivering community services (including IAG and positive activities). By the end of year 2, ten new organisations will deliver from these premises a range of services for young people and the wider community

- 4)** 2000 young people per year (of whom 10% are special needs and 10% BME) to have a perception of improved health, self esteem or self image as a result of taking part in an “ExtremeConnexions” based activity.

All these outcomes were achieved and exceeded. In regard to outcome 4, Youth Connexions have contributed towards achieving the outcome.
