Having judged the results of the assessment centre 3three candidates ahave been brought forward for interview.

S Guest then ran through how the assessment centre was organised.

- ✓ An analysis / briefing exercise: similar to an In-tray exercise but then the candidate had to brief a 'Cabinet' member.
- ✓ Group discussion exercise 70 adjectives to describe a leader
- ✓ One-to one with Sally and then an informal lunch with CMT.

The three candidates will be interviewed on:

- The significant issues facing Dacorum and how their appointment will contribute to addressing them.
- The wider context and where local government is at the moment.
