Dacorum Borough Council – 2012/13 Housing and Council Tax Subsidy Benefit certification fee

We issued our formal 'Certification of grants and returns annual report' on the 20 December 2013, to report the outcome from our audit work on your grant claims. Within this report, we set out the final audit fees in respect of those claims.

Since we issued that report, the Audit Commission has undertaken a global review of the audit scale fees in relation to the Housing and Council Tax Subsidy Benefit claim. Following this review, it has been determined that your Council is due a refund against the scale fee that has been levied of £5,000.

As a result, we need to revise the reported scale fees with our certification of grants and returns annual report, to report accurately the final fee position. Rather than re-issue a report, which has been through the committee cycle, I summarise the impact of this change below.
