Purpose of report:	This report sets out proposals to make the Performance Reward Grant balances accessible to the Destination Dacorum Board to spend on projects supporting the delivery of the Sustainable Community Strategy.		
Recommendations	Delegate approval of further draw downs from the earmarked Performance Reward Grant reserve for revenue and capital expenditure to the Section 151 Officer/Deputy Section 151 Officer in consultation with the Leader of the Council.

# BACKGROUND

- 1. Destination Dacorum acts as Dacorum's Local Strategic Partnership (LSP). The Destination Dacorum Board is chaired by Cllr Williams and includes representatives from:
  - a. Dacorum Borough Council
  - b. Hertfordshire County Council
  - c. Police
  - d. Health
  - e. Public Sector
  - f. Private Sector

2. In 2012, Full Council adopted the Destination Dacorum Plan as Dacorum Borough Council's Sustainable Community Strategy (SCS), for which it remains a statutory requirement for the Council to produce.

# PERFORMANCE REWARD GRANT (PRG)

- 3. Performance Reward Grant (PRG) was provided to Dacorum in two allocations in 2010.
- 4. In March 2010, Cabinet approved spend of PRG money via The Dacorum Partnership (our previous LSP).
- 5. The money was allocated as follows:

- 6. At the Dacorum Partnership Board meeting, 15th June 2011, the following recommendations were agreed for the remaining uncommitted PRG:
  - a. the Partnership do not start a second 'open bidding' process for community projects,
  - b. that the Sustainable Community Strategy be used to identify the major priority areas for action
  - c. that the remaining PRG be used to commission work that meets those priorities
  - d. that Officers work with appropriate agencies, partners and community groups to identify and bring forward a programme of work for consideration by the board.
- 7. The Destination Dacorum Board has since taken responsibility for the remaining PRG balances currently held by Dacorum Borough Council.
- 8. The remaining revenue grant balance is held within the Performance Reward Grant Earmarked Reserve. The capital grant balance is held within the Capital Grants and Contributions Unapplied Account.

#### THIS REPORT:

- 9. The Destination Dacorum Board have considered potential options for spending the outstanding PRG money and continue to discuss areas of their Plan where resources are, or will be, required.
- 10. At present, in order to spend outstanding PRG balances, Officers are required to prepare a report on each element of spend. Projects can be very small in nature and all supplementary estimates would require Full Council approval.
- 11. To enable quicker delivery of projects and initiatives which contribute to delivery of the Sustainable Community Strategy, approval is being sought to delegate authority from Full Council.
- 12. Any spend of the funds will enable delivery of the Sustainable Community Strategy (please see the Sustainable Community Strategy for specific work areas and priorities) and will focus on economic wellbeing in Dacorum.
- 13. It is recommended that supplementary estimates for expenditure funded from the Performance Reward Grant Balances be delegated to the Section 151 Officer / Deputy Section 151 Officer in consultation with the Leader of the Council.
