

Over 1,000 17 year old students in Dacorum received a full day on driving safe



All of Dacorum's senior schools received for year 12/13 a full and exiting day of road safety training, a local multi agency event consisting of drug Link Fire Service (Hemel crews) PCSO and Community Police, Trading standards and Ambulance trainee paramedics.

Morning sessions were 5 x 45 minutes on relevant subjects, Hemel staff covered seat belts, speed, distractions and consequences of a fatal accident and how it affected a family

The delivery of presentation by local Firefighters was done with passion, enthusiasm and to a very professional standard, many of the schools teaching staff openly said they were extremely impressed in the way they held the students attention and engaged with them. Local accidents, roads and conditions featured in their presentations.

Afternoon session was a full multi agency reconstruction car accident involving passengers and predestians, each agency displayed their methods of expertise in dealing with casualties and the need for close working with all emergency service
