Priorities for the Future

Tenants were asked to rank potential improvements to the service in order of importance. It was explained that we have to balance our budget by choosing how to spend their rent money and would like our tenants to help us decide how to do this by letting us know what is most important to them.

The 'ranking' method of responses was tested with office staff who said that they found it easy to understand. However, significant numbers of tenants who returned a form either did not make a response to this question or made an invalid response e.g. using the same number several times or ticking boxes. Of those who returned a completed the STAR survey, 65.9% of General Needs tenants but only 45.2% of Supported Housing tenants made a valid response to this question.

Five categories of improvement were stated on the form with an option for tenants to give their own suggestions. These tended to fall either within the remit of one of the existing categories or outside the remit of the Housing Landlord Service. Further details are given at the end of this document.
