1.0 Hemel Evolution Summary

The following summarises work on the town centre to date:

- ➤ **The Old Town**: one-way system with new paving and street furniture completed spring 2014
- ➤ **The Plough Zone**: new footpaths and street furniture in Heath Park completed October 2015 and the Plough roundabout benefitted from lighting improvements in October 2013.

Marlowes Shopping Zone:

- Pedestrianised Shopping Area and Bank Court works finished October 2015. Works included new paving, street furniture, trees and play-on-the-way planters together with a new events square; New Town Square with the rainbow stage to the south, a central sculpture with water jets and feature lighting, and an LED screen to the north. New paving continues through to Bank Court which leads to a new piazza style area with new planters and seating.
- Bus Interchange and Waterhouse Street works finished December 2015. Works included delivery of a new taxi rank and bus interchange along Bridge Street and Marlowes.
- ➤ Market Square: the Council is working with its development partner Endurance Estates and RG Carter to deliver a leisure facility with a cinema and restaurants. Works are expected to start mid-2018.
- ➤ **Jellicoe Water Gardens**: works commenced August 2015 and will continue through to October 2016.

> The Gade Zone:

- works on The Forum commenced in July 2015 and expect to finish January 2017
- works on the housing wrapping around the Forum expect to start in 2018
- the Health Centre are moving into Marlowes Business Centre

- Officers will be working with consultants to consider development options for the civic centre site.
