15/09/21	<p>Councillor Timmis queried if the Monsters on a Mission food recycling scheme would be rolled out to all schools in the Borough or if it just covered Hemel Hempstead.</p> <p>The Portfolio Holder believed it was just Hemel Hempstead schools at the moment but hoped it would be rolled out to all schools. He said he would confirm this with officers.</p>	Councillor Barrett	I can confirm that Monsters on a Mission is being rolled out to all Primary Schools within Dacorum.
15/09/21	<p>Councillor Maddern asked how the current figures for homelessness cases compared prior to Covid.</p> <p>The Portfolio Holder advised she would provide a written response.</p>	Councillor Griffiths	In 2017 estimated numbers in the borough were 14, during a spotlight count in November 2018 we identified 10 rough sleepers. At the height of summer 2019 identified numbers of rough sleepers in Dacorum was 22, with interventions implemented via Rough Sleeper Initiative and Next Steps Accommodation Programme, alongside the success of Everyone In this has reduced to the 3 reported currently. It is worth noting that the reported 3 does fluctuate between 3 and 6.
