Following a review of The Borough of Dacorum (Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead) (On Street Charging and Waiting & Loading Restrictions) Order 2022, a minor error had been discovered within the Article 21 of the above Traffic Regulation Order relating to Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead. It is therefore considered necessary to make the above traffic order in order to correct that error to enforce the newly introduced pay to park bays on Marlowes.

BACKGROUND

Following the Notice of Making relating to The Borough of Dacorum (Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead) (On Street Charging and Waiting & Loading Restrictions) Order 2022 a minor error was discovered by the Principal TRO Officer – TRO Services At Hertfordshire County Council pertaining to Article 21 of the above order as it relates to the 2007 legislation which has been revoked by the current 2022 legislation introduced on 31 May 2022.
