Bennetts	
End	At the last Health Committee Meeting I attended on 30 <sup>th</sup> November I reported the appalling condition of the Bennetts End Surgery overflow car park. The car park is necessary due to the 16,000 patients registered at the surgery. I have spoken to DBC officers who are reluctant to assist because they insist that to acknowledge its existence as a car park would be to contravene the 1906 Open Spaces Act as the car park was originally used as two Tennis Court. This is a car park used by my constituents and those in Leverstock Green, Nash Mills and other wards. The Lawn Tennis Association no longer see this as two of their Tennis Court. They did an excellent job in December re-surfacing the two Tennis Courts that are in use on Coronation Field as well as fitting a key pad entry system linked to the LTA App which is an excellent way to play free of charge. A patient or visitor will be injured walking to the Surgery from that car park. It is no longer wheelchair accessible as there are so many holes and ruts. Bennetts Gate shops lost its last remaining pharmacy, Boots on 3 <sup>rd</sup> February. The chemist was a lifeline when the Surgery in-house pharmacy was closed following the fire in May last year. Bennetts End Active Committee has organised a Festival of Women & Girls Sport for Saturday 8 <sup>th</sup> June and Hertfordshire Sports Partnership are hosting two Tennis events on 6 <sup>th</sup> & 13 <sup>th</sup> April. I have had a site visit to Coronation Field with Steve Maker from the Hertfordshire Football Association regarding
	a 3G Football pitch and last month a delegation of DBC Officers and Cllr. Bromham visited the Changing rooms on Coronation Field which were in a surprisingly good state of repair considering they have spent this century locked up.
