Title of Decision: Approval of a Framework Agreement with Bloom to issue a Direct Award to Arup to carry out the Phase 2 works of the HGC Infrastructure Delivery Plan (IDP)

Decision made and reasons:

Decision: A Framework Agreement is commissioned with Bloom to issue a Direct Award to Arup to carry out the Phase 2 works of the HGC Infrastructure Delivery Plan (IDP).

Reason: Following Arup's recent completion of IDPs for both Dacroum and St Albans Local Plans, an additional IDP is needed focussing on Hemel Hempstead and the HGC programme.

Arup recently started on Phase 1 of these activities in October 2024. Phase 1 commenced to allow sufficient time to set up a Direct Award Framework ahead of progressing the main part of the work in Phase 2. A Framework Agreement commissioning Arup for the Phase 2 works will allow Arup to provide outputs that are needed to inform the Dacorum and St Alban's Infrastructure Delivery Plans (IDPs) which is due for completion in April 2025; this is a fundamental consideration of a Local Plan examination.

Arup will develop an HGC IDP chapter for both Local Plan IDPs as well as updates to both Local Plan IDPs. The IDPs ensure there is proper consideration for the right infrastructure to support the growth and transformation of the town, and the outputs will also inform Planning Performance Agreements between landowners and Authorities as part of the planning application process.

Value for Money:

Arup are a specialist consultancy providing garden towns (such as Harlow and Gilston) with IDP expertise and their costs are competitive.

Financial:

Phase 1 costs - £31,557. Phase 2 costs - £52,500 includes 5% Bloom costs and 10% contingency Total - £84,057

Risk:

The IDP will set out the necessary infrastructure required to support growth at HGC and feed into the Planning Performance Agreements between landowners and Authorities including apportionment of costs required for the infrastructure delivery of the HGC programme.

If the IDP schedule is not met, there is a risk that the schedule will be delayed affecting evidence related to both regulation 19 Local Plans and Regulation 22 Submission.
